## MILESTONES

### Over \$1,000,000 Raised

Thanks to our incredible community of generous supporters, Homes 4 Homes raised nearly \$1.1 million in donations! We've now built a total of 775 homes that have impacted over 4,700 people in 11 communities.

### Wol-Lugung Church

The community of Wol-Lugung celebrated their first full year worshipping in a church building! This is the spiritual center of the community, providing worship services, Sunday school classes, choir practices, and more.

### Business Partners

In April, 2022 we launched our new business partner program. 38 individuals and businesses are actively engaged in this program, giving to Homes 4 Homes as a part of their business model.

### A Night of Generosity

It was indeed a milestone year for our annual fundraiser, A Night of Generosity. Over \$400,000 was raised at this event which funded a church building and homes for the entire community of Akecha, Uganda.

## COMMUNITIES ARE SELECTED

When selecting a community, it's important to us that we have a relationship with community leaders and ministry partners. These trusted relationships determine the locations we select and how deep we go into an area.



## WE MEET EACH FAMILY

Community leaders select every family that receives a home and manage the construction process. This structure allows us to walk alongside and support community leaders who know their people best.



## LET THE BUILDING BEGIN

Local laborers are a key component of each home. Local materials are used to construct each home that is consistent with the style of the communities in which they are built. All homes have a concrete floor and a permanent roof.



## WE DELIVER THE NEW HOME

The moment that a family receives their home - it's the highlight of our ministry. By providing a home, we are working to preserve families and allow them to raise their children in a safe, healthy environment.



## WE SHARE THE STORY WITH YOU

Donations are matched with funds for a family and we share their story and a photo of their completed home with the donor. Our financials are audited annually and we've received the highest level of transparency certification from Guidestar.



## TRANSFORM A COMMUNITY

We're committed to making a long term impact in each community we serve. Consistent support has greatly improved the health, safety, stability, and economic impact of families. We also evaluate if additional community needs are left outstanding. When necessary, we seek partners to meet those needs.

# Key Home Features



## Concrete Floor

Every home starts with a concrete floor, laying the foundation for a healthy and clean environment.



## Solid Roof Surface

A solid roof protects family members from weather elements and eliminates roof leaks.



## Strong Walls

Brick, concrete, or stucco walls built to stand the test of time and provide a legacy of shelter.



## Door & Window Locks

Locking doors and windows allow families to sleep and work in peace without fear.



## Latrines & Bathing

Latrines and bathing stalls spearhead sanitation initiatives to improve community health.



## Rain Water Systems

Rain-catch water systems are installed at the homesite if disability hinders travel to local well.



## Entrance Ramps

Entrance ramps are installed for elderly and families with disabilities to provide accessibility.



## Land Ownership

Local leaders confirm that each family owns the land their home is built on for sustainability.
